
Penthouse D, 8050 Vero Beach, Vero Beach

This modernist complex is a first for Vero Beach, the sleepy but charming town midway between Miami and Orlando on the Atlantic coast. The 18 house-size apartments are jigsawed together in three oceanfront buildings; some feature thoughtful touches like interior courtyards and private plunge pools.
