



Capti Hirams IRIVIBIA IR

From 1953 to 1961, the Atlantic Intracoastal Waterway was created by dredging a 12ft deep channel in the Indian River Lagoon. The dredging created 137 spoil islands throughout the 156 miles and 4 counties of the Indian River Lagoon. Thankfully we have quite a few right off our banks.

Our daily tours navigate through this haven for both native and exotic plants and animals. Many islands are surrounded by shallow sand bars or seagrass beds, which are a vital habitat and nursery area for many young fish species. These fish are an important food source and attract many animals (including humans). If you keep your eyes open you might be able to spot dolphin jumping in the wake of our boat, lumbering manatees and various shorebirds.

The River King also offers a sunset cruise to Pelican Island National Wildlife Reserve, the first federally protected nature reserve designated as a wildlife refuge.













SAVOR A RELAXING PADDLE AMONG THE ISLANDS

Both kayaks and stand-up paddle boards are a great option for those who would like to explore the waters of the Indian River Lagoon on their own, enjoying all the varied plant and wildlife. Imagine spending time relaxing on the beach of your own tranquil island. Head over to the Adventure Center located at Capt Hiram's Marina for more rental information.
