

Hotels in Houston, L.A. fill up for the World Series; some offer deals

Where can you stay for the World Series?

Game 3 of the World Series is heading to Houston this weekend, and hotels are already filling up.

The city's hotels have been playing host to displaced Hurricane Harvey residents. But there are rooms still available when the Series heads to [Houston](#)

(https://www.visithoustontexas.com/?gclid=CjwKCAjw7MDPBRAFEiwAppdF9HPmGYe9SPWKufTbc6ri5Mal8CASFrN4-wChYkNyZOZA-vpnFD6xoCxCnQAvD_BwE) on Friday.

A search on [Hotels.com](https://www.hotels.com) (<https://www.hotels.com>) for properties with room availability near Minute Maid Park showed a few pricey options. The Westin Houston downtown, for instance, is going for \$899 a night.

The Hyatt Regency Houston is \$501 a night. DoubleTree by Hilton Houston Downtown is \$499 a night.

All the properties are within a mile of the park.

Meanwhile, just 1 ½ miles away, Best Western Plus Downtown Inn & Suites is going for \$367 a night.

If you are willing to venture four miles away, Extended Stay America - Houston - Greenway Plaza will cost a more reasonable \$157 a night this weekend.

All prices and availability are based on a search Thursday morning for a stay from Friday to Monday, when the series leaves Houston and heads back to Los Angeles.

The Four Points LAX is offering a “Take Me Out to the Ball Game” package that includes a \$25 food and beverage credit per day to be used the hotel restaurant, Brewster’s, and discounted self-parking for \$20 a day. The package will be available until Nov. 1.

The Hollywood Hotel has a World Series Package for guests with tickets to the game. It included overnight accommodations, swag bag filled with Dodgers gear, and an Uber credit to and from the stadium.

The Langham Huntington Pasadena, Los Angeles' For the Love of the Game package includes accommodations, daily continental breakfast, a baseball sugar cookie, and in-room late night bites. Rates start at \$299. The package is valid until Nov. 5.

The Shore Hotel in Santa Monica is offering guests 29% off on Oct. 29 in honor of the Dodgers making it back to the World Series after 29 years. The package includes game day snacks. A two-night minimum is required. Standard rates apply for the second night.
