Guest rooms are on the smaller side but feature a mixture of modern and classical amenities like tufted leather headboards outfitted with reading lights, whimsical wallpaper, hardwood floors, black tiled bathrooms, rotary phones, and valet stands.

flock to The Langford for the PB Station restaurant from Pubbelly Boys chef Jose Mendin, a four-time James Beard nominee. PB Station promises to be a "fun, immersive dining experience" with a focus on steaks, seafood, and locally sourced produce. And the piece de resistance will be the rooftop bar and lounge, <a href="Pawn Broker">Pawn Broker</a>, offering hand-crafted cocktails, tapas-style bites, and killer views of downtown.
