By car

- 4.5 hours from Detroit
- 3.5 hours from Grand Rapids
- 7 hours from Chicago
- 7.5 hours from Cleveland
- 4.5 hours from Green Bay

By air

Pellston Regional Airport (PLN) offers direct commercial flights to and from Detroit and Chicago, with service by Delta and Lakeshore Express. Private charter flights to Mackinac Island are also available with Great Lakes Air.

By water

Three ferry companies offer complimentary parking on the mainland, departing from Mackinaw City or St. Ignace. Park the car, board a ferry and discover what it truly means to "get away from it all."
