INSPIRED SELECTIONS

Dom Perignon Brut 2006, Champagne, France 299

The holy grail of Sparkling wine. This wine exhibits a fresh stone fruit and citrus on the palate with hints of almonds and baked bread on the nose. Dom pairs well with salty foods like caviar and oysters.

Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label, Brut, Champagne 109

The most sought after Champagne in America shows elegant lemon tones on the palate and white flowers on the nose.

Palmes D'or 2002 Brut, Champagne 239

In France, the Palmes d'Or (or Golden Palm) is the most elevated distinction awarded to grace and talent. Palmes d'Or is the pinnacle of fine vintage Champagne. First aromas of white pear, peach, walnut and dried apricot fruit give way to secondary more intense aromas of pepper, ginger and red fruits. It has excellent structure and an incredibly long finish with unforgettable elegance.

Krug Brut Rose, Champagne 499

Perhaps the best food wine made. This Rose is creamy in texture, full of strawberry and rhubarb fruit, with notes of truffle and vanilla in the nose.

Prunotto 2009 Bussia Barolo D.O.C, Italy 169

The Bussia vineyard is one of the most prestigious single vineyards in the township of Monforte, the heart of the Barolo area. It lies 1,200 feet above sea level with a southern exposure. The Bussia Barolo begins with aromas of ripe berry fruit fused with floral and spicy notes. The flavor is intense and complex, with sweet and ample tannins and a very long finish.

**Antica Napa Valley 2008
Townsend Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa 179**

Set in the NW corner of the estate is a 40-acre parcel of land purchased from longtime friend and neighbor, Mrs. June Townsend. The Antinori family planted 24 acres of Cabernet Sauvignon there in 1999 and named it "Townsend Vineyard" in tribute. Deep aromas of sweet blackberries and cassis mingle with minerals, earth, spice and tobacco. Layered and intense fruit flavors lead to sweet tannins that are firm and well-integrated.

Heitz 2005 Cabernet Sauvignon, Martha's Vineyard, Napa 209

Considered to be the best vineyard site outside of France for Cabernet. This wine is full of powerful dark berry fruit, with an herbaceous nose of tarragon, with hints of anise and eucalyptus.

Hewitt 2011 Cabernet Sauvignon, Estate, Rutherford, Napa 269

The number two wine in the world last year. Hedonistic blackberry fruit and plum with Madagascar vanilla and coffee in the nose.

Quilceda Creek 2013 Cabernet Sauvignon, Columbia Valley, WA 359

This is a rich, ripe, concentrated wine with a liqueur-like texture and weight, blackberry, blueberry, cassis and plum fruit with nuances of violets, Asian soy, smoke, cedar, vanilla, minerals and black tea.

Stag's Leap Wine Cellars 2012 Cask 23 Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa 429

The story of CASK 23 began during the harvest of 1974. One lot from S.L.V. was so beautiful and deliciously distinct, the winery decided it should be bottled separately. On the palate the wine is full bodied with rich dark berry fruit, hints of cedar and white truffle that lead to a long fruit and spice-driven finish.

Stag's Leap Wine Cellars 2012 S.L.V Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa 239

Also known as Stag's Leap Vineyards, is the winery's first vineyard. Planted in 1970, it achieved international fame when three-year-old vines from the 1973 harvest produced a wine that bested some of France's greatest wines in a 1976 blind tasting known as the "Judgment of Paris." The powerful entry leads to a rich and full palate of black currant and red fruit with anise and cocoa top notes. The wine's structured tannins, concentrated fruit core and pleasing minerality leads to a lingering finish.

Opus One 2012, Napa 499

Opus one is a joint venture between the late Robert Mondavi and Baron Phillip de Rothschild the famous Bordeaux House of France. Opus is located in the heart of Napa Valley in the prime spot for growing Cabernet, and its large classics-inspired edifice is meant to impress. This winery is the poster-child for premium wine in Napa.
