Plan Your Escape If the Arizona heat makes you want to throw in the towel and hide out with your head in the freezer until September, make a reservation at one of these little getaways, where you can lay low in style—without the brain freeze.

Haven't been to Sedona in a while? Well, there's a relatively new reason to go—the **SEDONA ROUGE HOTEL & SPA**. Opened in June of last year, this retreat comes fully loaded with palatial suites, a spa, a fitness center and even a rooftop terrace that makes it all too easy to enjoy the red rock panoramas. And its proximity to Tlaquepaque and uptown Sedona only adds to the Sedona Rouge's charm.

For a little peace and quiet, check into the **RED SETTER INN AND COTTAGES** located in the White Mountain town of Greer, where there's a good chance you'll be able to hear the pine needles drop. Sitting on the banks of the Little Colorado River, this bed-and-breakfast offers fishing, hiking, mountain biking and, most important, plenty of redwood decks stocked with Adirondack chairs in which to lounge. Or you can plant yourself in the formal living room with a good book for a hushed afternoon. Another option in the area is the **GREER LODGE RESORT**. Pass the time in this northern retreat's on-site 373 Grill with a juicy steak and toe-tapping live music. Whichever you choose, you'll just be happy not to be sweating bullets. **E**
