The accommodations at Seven Stars Resort is what makes it one of the most extraordinary resorts in the Caribbean. There are several sleek six-story high rise buildings with luxurious accommodations that frame the outstanding zero-entry pool and the great beach access just beyond the pool.. These are truly home away from home type of suites. Families can choose from junior, one, two, three, or even four-bedroom suites. They have gone above and beyond most resorts in the Caribbean and have added modern amenities like complimentary Wi-Fi, top-notch toiletries, and necessities for families like washer and dryers, refrigerators, and microwaves.
