- 5. Reset and arrange table top
- 6. Assist server as needed with food delivery, especially with large parties and during peak periods
- 7. Set and reset the buffet station
- 8. Serve guests water, bread and butter upon their arrival, and provide refills as needed
- 9. Replenish buffet as needed
- 10. Ensure a positive guest experience in Dining Room
- 11. Ensure cleanliness of Dining Room
- 12. Promote Shawnee Inn and Golf Resort's service principles by example

Ancillary Duties:

1. Attends all mandatory in-service training and required meetings.

2. Performs tasks, which are supportive in nature to the essential functions of the job, but which may be altered or re-designed depending upon individual circumstances.

Physical Demands:
