Barthélemy ST. BART'S

The newest hotel on the Grand Cul de Sac specializes in tranquility. All of the 46 rooms and suites have drop-down screens that transform outdoor terraces into private spaces. French chef Guy Martin, of the two-Michelin-star Le Grand Véfour in Paris, developed the menus for the two restaurants. Book the "Picnic Chic" service and a concierge will pack beach chairs, a hamper of canapés, and a bottle of rosé for you to take to any of the island's secluded beaches.

Playa Grande **Beach Club** DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

Hidden away at the end of a pristine mile-long beach on the less visited north coast, Playa Grande Beach Club comprises a central great house and nine sea-facing, bohemian-chic bungalows done up in sherbet tones and mismatched prints. Take a sunset cruise along the dramatic limestone coast of the Laguna Gri-Gri. From \$800.

Villa Marie ST. BART'S


and she's behind the stylish Villa Marie, which opens in December on a landscaped hillside above picturesque Flamands Beach. The 19 bungalows and 2 villas have an understated vibe: seashell-rimmed mirrors, handwoven cordage lamps, and sunbleached wood. The resort boutique, curated by Sibuet,


Mile Beach and world-class scuba diving, has its first new resort in more than a decade. Most of the 266 rooms at the Seafire offer views showcasing the sunsets that inspired the property's name. The three restaurants include the seasonal, smallplate Ave, whose 24-seat chef's counter, Avecita, serves a Spanish tapas tasting menu. At the bar off the lobby, try a cocktail featuring tepache, a beverage made from fermented pineapple rinds.

Zemi Beach House **ANGUILLA**

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This beachfront retreat on Shoal Bay East-known for its sugar-white sands and low-key beach bars-has 54 guest rooms, 9 suites, and 27 larger residences, all with private outdoor spaces and sea views. The resort's showstopper is a 15,000-squarefoot spa, built within a wooden house transported from Thailand. The Rhum Room stocks more than 100 rums. From \$530.







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
